

Museum Wins the Jackpot Museo Se Gana La Loto

UtiLa is set for the arrival of a cultural history museum after \$30,000's in CHF grant money was awarded to its founders.

Neil Kehler and wife Julia Kehler were lucky enough to receive the maximum amount of grant money obtainable.

According to the proposal submitted by the Kehler family, the museum will occupy the corner of a three story building located on her own land on Caha Mica Road.

The museum will house a collection of glass bottles, dining back to 1860, including a selection of those recently found on the site.

Further display cases will exhibit coinage, stamps, historical documents, a variety of pearls and maritime artifacts amongst other pieces, yet to be obtained.

One of the most contemporary and dynamic displays will see a variety of local residents recording monologues of their own memories and tales of old.

Through this, Mr. Kehler hopes to "wake up the local community to their past through nostalgia".

Further details of a UtiLa dialect dictionary are being held under wraps and an opportunity to explore family trees is also on the cards.

Being one of only a select few in the country, the museum could potentially entice a new breed of visitor to UtiLa, diversifying the islands growing tourism industry.

Particulars regarding the funding and management of the museum have yet to be worked out and details of forthcoming job opportunities are uncertain.

Building work on the site has temporarily ceased as a portion of the grant money present un-

obtainable, the Kehler's are working on rectifying this situation.

Cash donations can be made to the museum through the couple who can be located at the Jade Seahorse restaurant.

En el museo encontrará o habitará una botella de vidrio que data desde 1860 y que han sido catalogadas por el Sr. Kehler y otros recientes aliados por el mismo.

Posteriormente se exhibirán estampas, monedas, documentos históricos, una variedad de perlas y artefactos marítimos entre otros detalles que se obtendrán eventualmente.

En una de las vitrinas contemporáneas y dinámica verá la variedad de residentes locales que tracen recuerdos monólogos de sus propias memorias y cuentos de vejez, por medio de lo cual la Sr. Kehler tiene la esperanza de "despertar a la comunidad local a su pasado histórico y gestión de la industria turística".

Los detalles de un diccionario de dialecto de UtiLa se están manteniendo bajo wraps y una oportunidad de explorar los árboles genealógicos también está en las cartas.

Debido a que una porción de los fondos presentes en el sitio no son utilizables, los Kehler's están

trabaja potencial para atraer más visitas a la isla diversificado así su desarrollo turístico.

La construcción del edificio les a costado una gran cantidad de dinero a las Kehler, están trabajando para reclutar, su situación, donaciones en efectivo se pueden hacer a la propiedad del restaurante en la localidad del restaurante Jade Seahorse. ■

Now under new management the bar has been renovated

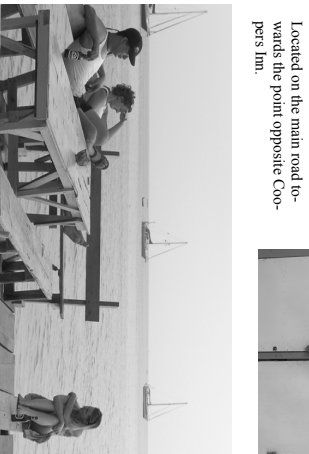


combining atmospheric lighting and ambient music and, although simple in style, these responsible for re-education the paid close attention to details.
